Distribution of Holy Communion

If you are Coeliac, you are welcome to receive Communion at any Mass by coming to the altar at the time of the Our Father. Please come to the righthand side; Ministers of Eucharist will be on the left.

Cemetery Sunday will take place as usual, on the last Sunday of June, this year the 26th June, in St Peter's Cemetery at 3.00pm, and Newtown Cross Cemetery at 5.00pm. We are delighted that for the first time in three years we can come together in person in the Cemeteries. As always, people are invited to prepare their family graves for the blessing.

Public Mass & Services

1. In line with Government permission, **all Masses and ceremonies** in both St Peter's and Our Lady of Lourdes Churches, including funerals, weddings and baptisms, can proceed.
