Two Drogheda based communities of nuns, the Medical Missionaries of Mary, Beechgrove, and the Dominican Nuns of the Monastery of St Catherine of Siena, The Twenties, will feature in a new TV documentary examining the role of religious sisters in Ireland. In "The Last Nuns in Ireland", which will be broadcast at 10.15pm, this Tuesday, 16th January 2024 on RTÉ ONE, Newry born journalist and broadcaster Dearbhail McDonald, sets out to examine the role of female religious sisters in Ireland, from earliest times to the present day, to see how they have shaped Irish lives - for better or for worse, as well as looking to the future in a time of fewer vocations.
