Stations of the Cross in Our Lady of Lourdes Church each Sunday during Lent at 5.00pm. Led by the priests and deacons of the Parish.

Lent is a special time of prayer, penance and almsgiving. Attendance at daily Mass, if possible, is commendable.

There is a **second envelope** this weekend 18th February, for the national services offered by the Irish Bishops Conference which includes the following: Pastoral Renewal and Youth Ministry; Catholic Education; Marriage, Family, Migrants & Pastoral Care; National Safeguarding of Children; Communications; Worship Faith Development. The Bishops Conference also has various social outreaches, including a Drugs Initiative and support for Irish prisoners overseas.

St Elizabeth Convent of Minsk, Belarus, will once again visit St Peter's Parish, on Monday 19th February at the three morning Masses. They sell various religious and secular articles produced with love and prayer in the convent's workshops. The convent provides spiritual and social help to the sick and the suffering. Since its establishment the sisters have been patronizing 200 orphaned children with psychophysical needs. They also run a recovery shelter for 200 men (homeless, drug or alcohol addicts, ex- prisoners and the less able), as well as a rehabilitation facility for women. More than twenty workshops and studios operate under the aegis of the nuns, including sewing and embroidery shops, candle workshop, wood-carving, stone and blacksmith workshops and many more. St Elisabeth Convent bears the name of the holy Martyr. Grand Princess Elisabeth. It was founded in 1999 and currently counts some one hundred nuns.

Trócaire: Trócaire boxes are available in the churches. Trócaire is the overseas development agency of the Catholic Church in Ireland. The Trócaire Lenten campaign this year takes inspiration from the prophet Amos who says: "Let justice flow like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream" (Amos 5:24). This Lent, we are called to join the river of justice and peace. On this year's Trócaire box we meet Malita and her 12-year-old twins Patricia and Patrick from the Machinga district in Malawi. Trócaire, with your support, has been working with partners in Malawi for the last forty-eight years. Malita is the single mother of six children and her family's story is unfortunately one that is typical in Malawi as they struggle every day with no direct access to clean water for the household. The effects of climate change have worsened this struggle, and their situation is even more precarious now, due to drought and extreme weather events. The impacts are serious.
